

Justin Bieber was found dead Saturday afternoon in his New York City hotel room by on-again, off-again girlfriend, Selena Gomez. The 20-year-old pop sensation suffered tragically from a heroin overdose.

Gomez and Bieber had reservations that evening at Serendipity, but Gomez received a public tweet from Bieber at 3:05 p.m. that day stating:

“I have something I have to talk to you about.”

When she received no response after calling Bieber multiple times, she decided to meet him at his hotel room.

Bieber’s body wasn’t the only thing Gomez discovered when she entered his hotel suite around 4 p.m. at the Plaza Hotel in Manhattan, NY. Crying hysterically in the hotel bathroom, Gomez found One Direction band member, Harry Styles. The two seemed to have been secretly rendezvousing on the eve and day of Bieber’s death.

Upon Gomez’s arrival, she called for medical help and was met by the Plaza Hotel doctor, Phil Sprenkle. Sprenkle announced Bieber dead on the scene.

“I think he was dead for about an hour. It was high-grade heroin and he had way too much.”

Styles, whom had been too emotional to call 911, calmed himself enough to relay,

“I didn’t know what to do because this is how Justin usually writes his songs.”

Styles, who continuously sobbed through the entire discovery, told reporters before he was escorted from the room,

“Selena will never love him as much as I do. He even wrote a song for me called Nothing Like Us.”

Gomez had no reply to the comment.

The Canadian pop star's drug abuse had been spiraling out of control after he purchased property in Atlanta, GA in 2013, but no one expected an overdose.

Gomez stated, "I always knew he was gay, but I never thought he would overdose."

Usher, who had mentored Bieber after his discovery on YouTube, was one of those that did not expect Bieber to come to such a tragic end.

"I can't believe this happened, he had such a bright future. He let fame get the best of him."

Jayden Smith had looked up to Bieber and commented,

"He was like a brother to me. He was talented and will be missed."
